



## **LEVEL 3 EXTENDED DIPLOMA IN MUSICAL THEATRE/DANCE FAQ'S**

### **Q. HOW DOES THE COURSE RUN?**

A. Students will study on a 2-year programme with the option to choose specialist modules with a Dance and/or Musical Theatre focus. The Level 3 Diploma offers up to 18-hours of study time per week over a 30-week period. Students will have the option to pay for an additional enhancement programme which will offer up to an additional 12-hours of study to enhance their training. Those on the enhancement programme will focus on a more intense industry specific pathway.

In addition, students will have the opportunity to study for vocational examinations in dance and Musical Theatre and to study for a Level 4 Diploma in Theatre Arts: Performance or Teacher Pathway in their 2nd year.

### **Q. WHAT ARE THE FEES?**

A. The Level 3 Diploma is government funded, which covers the 18 hours of training each week for all eligible UK based students. The enhancement programme is an additional £4000 per year, which can be paid in instalments. Fees do not include any uniform, equipment, external trips, or any additional exam fees for other qualifications studied.

Scholarship auditions will be held for successful applicants in March 2024. If you are successful in being offered a place on the course, details and criteria for this will be sent to you directly with your offer letter.

## **Q. WHAT ARE THE CONTACT HOURS AND WHAT CLASSES DOES THIS INCLUDE?**

A. The Level 3 Diploma will offer up to 18-hours a week of study. The enhancement programme will offer an additional 10-12 hours of study each week.

Weekly dance classes will include ballet, jazz technique, contemporary and street/commercial. Students will also attend weekly acting, voice, singing technique and ensemble singing classes, which with their contextual sessions form their core classes for the Level 3 Diploma. The enhancement programme will offer students the opportunity to further develop their craft with industry professionals in classes such as Integrated Project (Song & Dance), Acting Through Song, Acting for Audition, Singing Repertoire, Acro, Tap, Hip Hop. The enhancement programme will be structured to suit the demands of the cohort and more detail will be given on this at the point of offer onto the course.
